

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS

ORDINANCE NO. 102

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT SPECIFIC LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS

“**Traffic Control Devise**” as that term is used in this Ordinance, shall mean any sign, signal or marking, including markings upon pavement and curbs, installed within the City at the direction of the Director of Traffic Control for the purpose of directing and controlling traffic within the City or to guide or warn traffic within the City.

SECTION 2. TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

The City Council of the City of Lowry Crossing, acting within its legislative discretion, hereby authorizes the installation of the following Traffic Control Devices at the places designated within the corporate limits of the City:

STOP SIGNS

Control Device Number	Type Of Control Device	Location
SS-1.	Stop Sign	Controlling East Bound Overland Drive at Meadow Drive.
SS-2.	Stop Sign	Controlling West Bound Overland Drive at Meadow Drive.
SS-3.	Stop Sign	Controlling North Bound Meadow Drive at Overland Drive.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE

All parts of ordinances, inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

If any article, paragraph or subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE

An offense committed before the effective date of this ordinance is governed by the prior law and ordinances, as amended, in effect when the offense was committed and the former law is continued for this purpose.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.


