

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS

ORDINANCE NO. 104

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY SPEED CODE ORDINANCE BY ADDING THERETO A PROVISION MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE A VEHICLE ON THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC STREET WITHIN THE CITY AT A SPEED GREATER THAN 15 MILES PER HOUR, TO WIT: COTTRELL LANE, IN ITS ENTIRETY; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO SPEED CODE ORDINANCE

That Section 3 "Speed On Specific Streets" of City of Lowry Crossing Speed Code Ordinance be amended to add the new designated street shown in bold type and bringing forward from prior ordinances those streets not listed in bold type. Said Section 3 shall read as follows:

“SECTION 3 SPEED OF SPECIFIC STREETS

A person commits an offense if he operates or drives a vehicle on the following designated streets at a speed greater than the speed designated by this Section for that street or portion of that street; and any speed in excess of the limit provided in this section shall be prima facie evidence that the speed is not reasonable nor prudent and is unlawful:

STREET	PORTION OF STREET	SPEED: Miles Per Hour
Cottrell Lane	In its entirety	15
Lake Trail	In its entirety	20
Lakeway Trails	In its entirety	20
Overland	In its entirety	20
Settlers Trail	In its entirety	20
Traildust	In its entirety	20”

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE

All parts of ordinances, inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed. Ordinance No. 104, shall continue in full force and effect except as amended herein.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

If any article, paragraph or subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE

An offense committed before the effective date of this ordinance is governed by the prior law and ordinances, as amended, in effect when the offense was committed and the former law is conditioned for this purpose.

SECTION 5. PENALTY CLAUSE

Any person firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each and every offense shall constitute a new and separate offense.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage and publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
