ORDINANCE NO. 172

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS, ACCEPTING WOODCREEK DRIVE, MEADOWWOODS CIRCLE AND CEDAR HILL CIRCLE AS PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Woodcreek Drive, Meadowwoods Circle and Cedar Hill Circle were dedicated to the City of Lowry Crossing as public rights-of-way by plat filed July 22, 1983, and recorded in Volume C, Page 671 of the Map/Plat Records of Collin County, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, at the time of said dedication the City of Lowry Crossing did not accept said rights-of-way as public streets, as the City had no means of maintaining such rights-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 21, 2001, the City of Lowry Crossing began adopting a tax rate for the city; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's tax-rate provides a means to maintain said rights-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that it is in the public interest to accept said rights-of-way as public streets within the City of Lowry Crossing; Now, Therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS:**


**Section 1.** That Woodcreek Drive, Meadowwoods Circle and Cedar Hill Circle, as platted and dedicated by plat filed July 22, 1983, and recorded in Volume C, Page 671 of the Map/Plat Records of Collin, County, Texas, and as subsequently developed, are hereby accepted as public streets within the City of Lowry Crossing, Texas.

**Section 2.** That a copy of the plat dedicating said rights-of-way shall be attached to this ordinance to show the location and dimensions of the accepted rights-of-way.

**Section 3.** That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

**DULY ADOPTED** by the City Council of the City of Lowry Crossing, Texas, this the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2003.






