




ORDINANCE NO. 183

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 109, AS AMENDED, BY DESIGNATING THE MAYOR AS THE JUDGE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE CITY COUNCIL BY ORDINANCE PROVIDES FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND QUALIFICATIONS OF A JUDGE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lowry Crossing, Texas, has by ordinance and in compliance with state law established a municipal court; and

**WHEREAS**, there is currently no appointed municipal judge to preside over said court; and

**WHEREAS**, the city council desires to designate the mayor as municipal judge in order to allow the court to operate and the ordinances to be enforced until such time as the council provides for the appointment and qualifications of the judge; and

**WHEREAS**, the city council finds that it is in the public interest to adopt this ordinance; Now, Therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1. MUNICIPAL COURT ORDINANCE AMENDED.** That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 109, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**"SECTION 3. MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE**


A. Pursuant to Section 29.004 of the Government Code, the Mayor is hereby designated the Municipal Judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Lowry Crossing, Texas, until such time as the city council by ordinance provides for the appointment and qualifications of the judge."

**SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE.** That all parts of ordinances, inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed. Ordinance No. 135 is hereby specifically repealed.


**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
