

ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS ESTABLISHING A REQUIREMENT THAT TRASH FOR PICK UP SHALL BE IN COVERED RIGID CONTAINERS; PROVIDING A REPEALER, PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF:

WHEREAS, the municipality of Lowry Crossing currently has an Ordinance Number 27 regulating trash for pick up; and

WHEREAS, trash strewn from broken containers constitutes a public health hazard and public nuisance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen voted on February 8, 1988 to amend that ordinance to add the requirement for rigid containers; and

WHEREAS, such amended ordinance has not been found in the current municipality records.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to require that all trash for pickup within the boundaries of Lowry Crossing must be in a covered rigid container.

SECTION 2. Repealer

This ordinance replaces and repeals ordinance no. 27 in its entirety.

SECTION 3. Severability Clause

If any part of this ordinance should be declared unconstitutional or invalid by any judgement of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any other remaining clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of the ordinance.

SECTION 4. Publication and Effective Date

The caption of this ordinance shall be published one (1) time in a newspaper having general circulation in the Town of Lowry Crossing, and shall be effective 60 days following publication.
