AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LOWRY CROSSING, COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, CHANGING ITS FORM OF GOVERNMENT FROM A TYPE B GENERAL LAW MUNICIPALITY TO A TYPE A GENERAL LAW MUNICIPALITY AND PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, RECORDING AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Lowry Crossing is a type B general law municipality;

WHEREAS, the Town of Lowry Crossing has 600 or more inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that its is in the best interests of the citizens of the Town of Lowry Crossing to change the form of Lowry Crossing's government from Type B to Type A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. CHANGE TO TYPE A.

Pursuant to Chapter 6, Subchapter B of the Texas Local Government Code, the Town of Lowry Crossing hereby changes from a Type B to a Type A general law municipality.

SECTION 2. CONFLICTS.

All ordinances and provisions of the Town of Lowry Crossing, Texas, that are in conflict with this Ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all ordinances and provisions of ordinances of said Town not so repealed are hereby retained in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

It is the intent of the Town Council that if any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this Ordinance be deemed severable and, should any such paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section be declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, such declaration of invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed to affect the validity of those provisions of this Ordinance left standing, nor the validity of any ordinances of the Town of Lowry Crossing.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall be effective from and after the date the same has been adopted by the Lowry Crossing Town Council.


SECTION 5. RECORDING.
