

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTIVE POSITION OF FIRE COMMISSIONER, DESCRIBING THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE POSITION; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, The City of Lowry Crossing wishes to have an appointive position of Fire Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, The City Council wishes to clarify the duties and responsibilities of the position of Fire Commissioner for the City of Lowry Crossing.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS:

Section 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to define the position of Fire Commissioner for the City. This requires repealing Ordinance 26 dated May 1, 1985 and re-establishing what the City Council expects of the person appointed to fill this position. The Fire Commissioner is responsible for providing City Council a quarterly recap of fire department activities, other items of interest and/or information as required, and a quarterly financial status showing any significant variations from the current year budget. Each August a summarized budget showing expected income and expense projections for the coming fiscal year will be provided to the City Council. Additionally the Fire Commissioner may be asked to respond to questions asked of the City concerning the Fire Department.

Section 2. REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

If any part of this ordinance should be declared unconstitutional or invalid by any judgement of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any other remaining clause, sentence, paragraph or section of the ordinance.


Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE
