

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS

ORDINANCE NO. 96

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS ANNEXING PORTIONS OF CERTAIN ROADS AND PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY ADJACENT TO THE EXISTING CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING; AND EXTENDING MUNICIPAL CONTROL OVER SUCH NEWLY ANNEXED ROADS AND RIGHTS OF WAY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lowry Crossing held the public hearings required by law to consider the annexation of certain roads and public rights of way; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lowry Crossing believes that the extension of the corporate limits along such roads and public rights of way provides added protection to the citizens of the City of Lowry Crossing, Texas, thereby promoting orderly growth and development of the City of Lowry Crossing; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWRY CROSSING, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That the following portion of the roads and public rights of way herein described be, and the same are hereby, annexed to and included into the City of Lowry Crossing, Texas and/or incorporated into the City for all lawful purposes pursuant to the powers possessed by the City of Lowry Crossing, Texas, a general-law municipality duly organized under the laws of the State of Texas; and such public roads and public rights of way annexed and incorporated herein are described as follows, to wit:

That portion of Bridgefarmer Road, situated in Collin County Texas in the E. Tones Survey, Abstract No. 495, the R. H. Lock Survey, Abstract No. 517, the J.H. Long Survey, Abstract No. 541, the J. Snively Survey, Abstract No. 863 and the H. Wright Survey, Abstract No. 957, and being more particularly described as follows:

**BEGINNING** at a point in the south right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 380 at its intersection with the east right-of-way line of Bridgefarmer Road (Bridgefarmer Road also known as Milligan Road);

**THENCE** in a southerly direction along the east right-of-way line of Bridgefarmer Road to a point in the north right-of-way of Farm to Market Road 546;

**THENCE** in a westerly direction along the north right-of-way line of Farm to Market Road 546 to a point in the west right-of-way line of Bridgefarmer Road;

**THENCE** in a northerly direction along the west right-of-way line of Bridgefarmer Road to a point in the south right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 380;

**THENCE** in an easterly direction along the south right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 380 to the place of beginning.

#### SECTION 2.

That from and after the date of this ordinance, the City of Lowry Crossing shall exercise any and all necessary and appropriate powers bestowed upon a general-law municipality in the State of Texas for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Lowry Crossing, Texas.

#### SECTION 3.

That from and after the date of this ordinance, the City of Lowry Crossing shall exercise any and all necessary and appropriate powers bestowed upon a general-law municipality in the State of Texas for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Lowry Crossing, Texas.

#### SECTION 4.

That the city limits of the City of Lowry Crossing, Collin County, Texas, be, and the same are hereby extended to include the above described tracts within the city limits of the City of Lowry Crossing, and the same shall hereafter be included within the territorial limits of said City, and all inhabitants thereof shall hereafter be entitled to all the rights and privileges as other citizens of the City of Lowry Crossing, and they shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of said City.

#### SECTION 5.


That should any portion of the tracts of land described herein not be subject to annexation by the City of Lowry Crossing, such fact shall not affect or invalidate the annexation of any area above described which is legally subject to being annexed by the City of Lowry Crossing.

SERVICE PLAN  
FOR ANNEXATION OF BRIDGEFARMER ROAD

The area to be annexed is a road or street. The City will provide the following:

1. Police protection shall be provided in accordance with existing City policy through the Collin County Sheriff's Department.
2. Fire protection shall be provided in accordance with existing City policy through Volunteer Fire Department.
3. Solid waste collection shall be provided in accordance with existing City policy that authorizes collection of solid waste by a private company or companies authorized to conduct such activities within the City.
4. Maintenance of water facilities shall be provided in accordance with existing City policy through Milligan Water Supply Corporation. Waste water facilities are provided by individual property owner septic systems.
5. Maintenance of roads and streets shall be provided in accordance with existing City policy which includes an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the City of Lowry Crossing and Collin County.
